- /a The set aside for state school improvement activities under Title I-A is increased from 4 percent to 7 percent in lieu of a separate program.
- /b Similar activities are now authorized under Comprehensive Literacy State Development Grants (ESSA Title II-B-2).
- /c Similar activities are now authorized under Innovative Approaches to Literacy (ESSA Title II-B-2, section 2226).
- /d Similar activities are now authorized under Well-Rounded Educational Opportunities (ESSA Title IV-A-1, section 4107).
- /e Similar activities are now authorized under Safe and Healthy Students (ESSA Title IV-A-1, section 4108).
- /f Similar activities are now authorized under Programs of National Significance: School Leader Recruitment and Support (ESSA Title II-B-4, section 2243).
- /g Similar activities are now authorized under Programs of National Significance: Supporting Effective Educator Development (ESSA Title II-B-4, section 2242).
- /h Similar activities are now authorized under American History and Civics Education (ESSA Title II-B-3).
- /i Similar activities are now authorized under Grants for the Effective Use of Technology (ESSA Title IV-A-1, section 4109).
- /j From the amounts made available under National Activities: Academic Enrichment (ESSA Title IV-F-4), the Secretary must make awards annually under each of three programs: Assistance for Arts Education (section 4642); Ready to Learn Programming (section 4643); and, Javits Gifted and Talented Students Education (section 4644).
- /k The Secretary must use a portion of the funds made available under National Activities: National Activities for School Safety (ESSA Title IV-F-3) for the Project SERV program (section 4631).
- /l Similar activities are now authorized throughout the ESSA.
- /m The authorization of appropriations is included under Expanding Opportunity Through Quality Charter Schools (ESSA Title IV-C). The Credit Enhancement Initiatives program under current law had a separate authorization for FY 2002 and FY 2003 only. It has continued to receive appropriations each fiscal year.
- /n Under current law, a single authorization under Title V-D covers programs included in Title V-D-1 through V-D-21. Title V-D-1 provides the Secretary with the authority to support "nationally significant programs."
- /o The Secretary must use not less than 95 percent of the amount available for National Activities: Community Support for School Success (ESSA Title IV-F-2) to award grants competitively for the Promise Neighborhoods (section 4624) and Full-Service Community Schools (section 4625) programs. For each fiscal year, the Secretary must award not fewer than 3 grants under Promise Neighborhoods, and not fewer than 10 grants under Full-Service Community Schools.
- /p Under Comprehensive Literacy State Development Grants (ESSA Title II-B-2), the Secretary may also award grants competitively to support the Innovative Approaches to Literacy program (section 2226).
- /q Similar activities are now authorized under Teacher and School Leader Incentive Fund Grants (ESSA Title II-B-1).
- /r Reconstituted under a new early learning collaboration and coordination program (ESSA Title IX-B, section 9212), although it retains the same program title.
- /s From the amount available under American History and Civics Education (ESSA Title II-B-3), the Secretary must reserve not less than 26 percent for Presidential and Congressional Academies (section 2232); and, not more than 74 percent for National Activities (section 2233).
- /t Currently funded under ESEA V-D-1.
- /u Similar activities are now authorized under Well-Rounded Educational Opportunities (ESSA Title IV-A-1, section 4107) and National Activities: Academic Enrichment/Assistance for Arts Education (ESSA Title IV-F-4, section 4642).
- /v Reconstituted as Grants for Statewide Family Engagement Centers (ESSA Title IV-E).
- /w Should Congress appropriate more than \$369.1 million for State Assessments Grants (ESSA Title I-B), then the Secretary is authorized to award grants competitively for purposes similar to those supported under the existing Grants for Enhanced Assessment Instruments program, which is consolidated here.
- /x Similar activities are now authorized under National Activities: Grants for Education Innovation and Research (ESSA Title IV-F-1).
