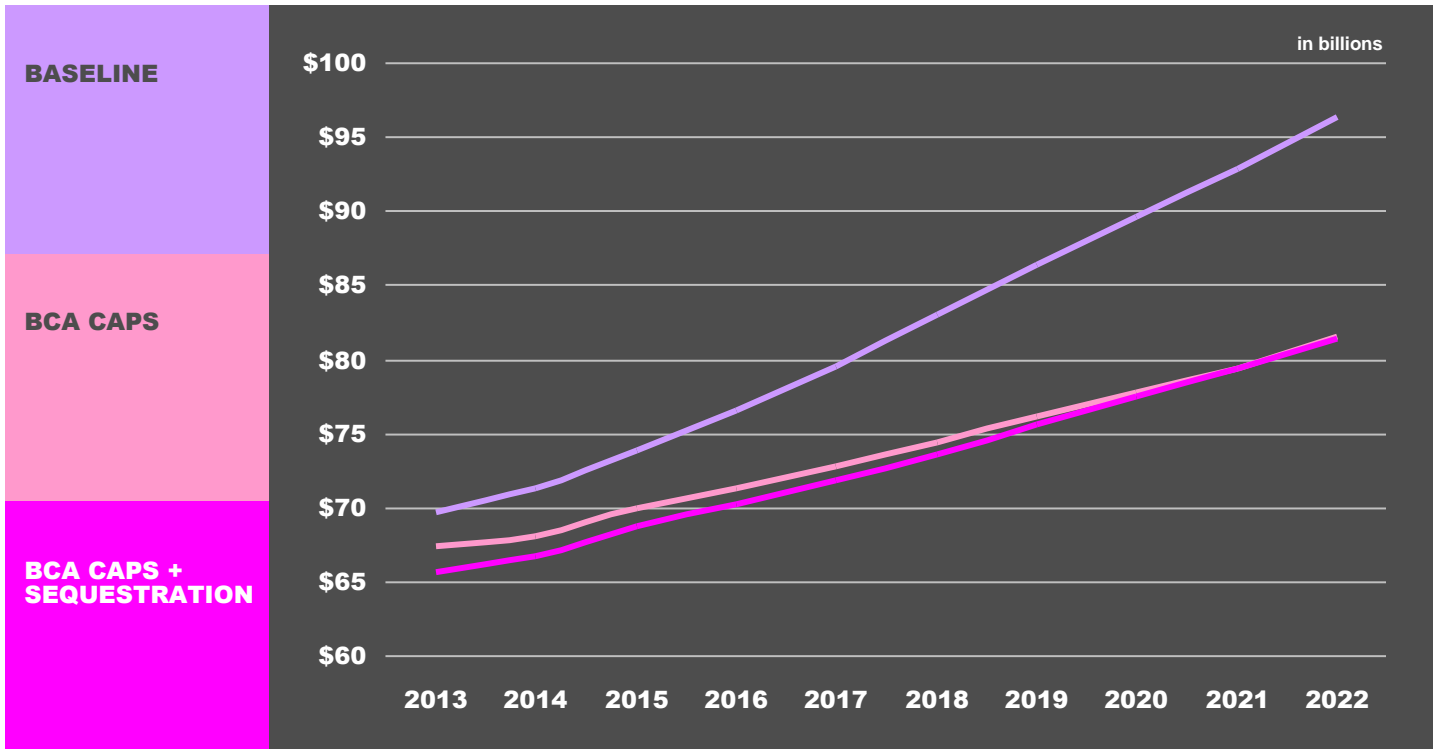


# U.S. Department of Education Discretionary Funding

## Baseline

The Education Department's actual discretionary funding for fiscal year 2012, adjusted each year thereafter for inflation and enrollment.

## BCA Caps

Assumes the Education Department's discretionary funding grows at the same rate as the Budget Control Act's (BCA) nondefense discretionary spending caps.

## Caps + Sequestration

Assumes the Education Department's discretionary funding grows at the same rate as the Budget Control Act's (BCA) nondefense discretionary spending caps with automatic spending reductions (or sequestration).
