Keynote Address

Mini-Plenary Sessions feature a panel of experts and/or practitioners who will focus on a broad issue that impacts today's schools and society. Conference participants can choose to attend two of these two-hour Mini-Plenary sessions on the first day, if they are not registered to attend a Learning Lab.

Men's Issues Mini-Plenary Session features experts from the field who will address issues of particular concern to men. Participants will have the chance to attend two of these two-hour sessions as an alternative to attending the other Mini-Plenary sessions or Learning Labs.

Learning Labs provide hands-on learning delivered by content experts in a four-hour time block. Because enrollment is limited, participants must register in advance and will be notified by E-mail of their acceptance. Confirmed participants will attend their Learning Lab instead of attending Mini-Plenary sessions on the first day.

Workshops are two-hour sessions on the second day featuring one or more presenters who will concentrate on a specific issue or skill of significant importance to ethnic minorities and women. Conference participants can choose to attend two different two-hour workshops.
