Special Education Programs



Proposed funding, FY 2019: maintains funding for IDEA programs compared to FY 2017; however, because the number of students needing special services is expected to increase, the **federal share** of the excess cost of these services is expected to drop to **13.8 percent, the lowest level since 2000**. In addition, funding for Special Olympics education programs would be eliminated. The Department's rationale for elimination: the activities are better supported with other Federal, State, local, or private funds.
