How to access the site:

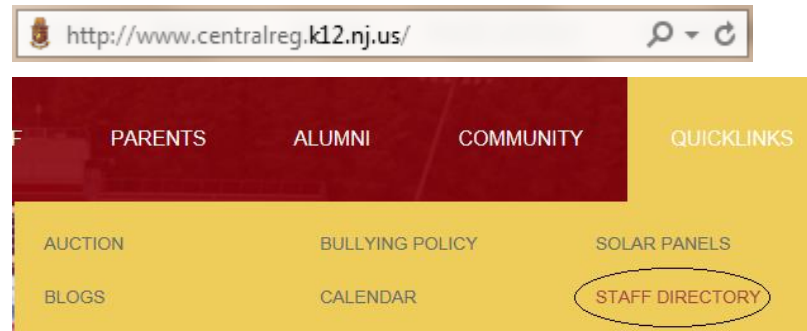
1. Go to Central Regional's homepage
