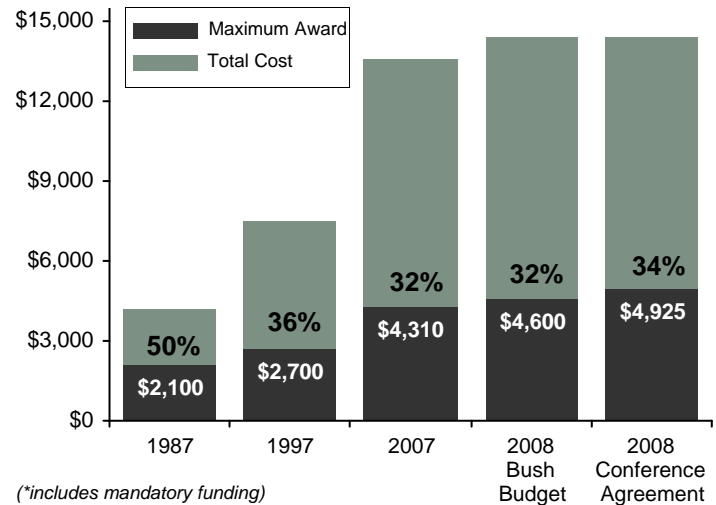


Federal Pell Grants

Federal Pell Grants

- Funding provided in the 2008 Conference Agreement, along with mandatory funds provided in the College Cost Reduction Act of 2007, would boost the maximum Pell Grant award to \$4,925 from \$4,310 in 2007.
- Under the 2008 Conference Agreement, the average funding amount per district is \$36 million, or an average increase of \$3.1 million more than the Bush budget request.
- The 2008 Conference Agreement rejects the Bush budget proposal to pay for an increase in Pell Grants by cutting other student aid. The Conference Agreement also funds all other student aid programs.
