

NEA-Retired Website Awards

Presented at the NEA-Retired Annual Meeting in June, the NEA-Retired Website Awards recognize exemplary websites of NEA-Retired state associations.

Award Criteria:

- The websites will be evaluated on: design; message development; user friendliness; effectiveness in showcasing members, their interests, and issues; and quality of communication to Retired members regarding retirement issues, including (but not limited to): COLAs, insurance, health care, pensions and community service.
- Only one nomination per application will be accepted.
- All nominations must be postmarked by **April 15** of the award year, and submitted materials will not be returned.

Required Documents: Three copies of the Nomination Form

Selection of the Award

Members of the NEA-Retired Communications Committee will ensure that the applications meet the eligibility requirements and will select the winners.

Communications Hall of Fame Winners

A website that has earned the NEA-Retired Website Award three times in the same category becomes a member of the NEA-Retired Hall of Fame. Once it receives a Hall of Fame designation, the website is not eligible to be submitted in that same category for three years thereafter. The years do not have to be consecutive to receive this honor.
