The Terrible, Horrible, No Good, Very Bad Pay for Graduate Employees

Federal salary data shows the dilemma that many graduate employees face: Do I pay for food this month? Or do I pay my medical bills?

In 2018-2019, the average graduate employee (GA) stipend was about \$18,500. (GAs additionally received tuition and fee waivers worth about \$7,500.)

Research assistants earned slightly more, \$19,000, than teaching assistants, \$17,000, while graduate associates earned \$22,000, on average. But within disciplines, pay varied widely from a low of \$14,042 in library science to a high of \$26,968 in health residency programs.
