Both the CARES Act and CRRSA Act provided funding to Governors through the Governor's Emergency Education Relief (GEER) Fund. The U.S. Department of Education is required to allocate 60 percent of the funds based on each state's relative population of individuals aged 5 through 24, and 40 percent based on each state's relative number of children counted under the Title I, Part A formula.

GEER funds may be used by the Governor of Florida in support of public elementary and secondary education, institutions of higher education (IHEs), or other education-related entities. A Governor has wide discretion in determining the entities in the State that will receive GEER funds. A Governor can choose to fund only LEAs, only IHEs, only education-related entities, or any combination of eligible entities.
