Across all three federal laws (CARES, CRRSA, and ARP), SEAs must use at least 90 percent of their grant awards to make subgrants to LEAs in proportion to the amount of funds that each LEA received under Title I, Part A in the most recent fiscal year.

GEER

Allocations to Maine

Both the CARES Act and CRRSA Act provided funding to Governors through the Governor's Emergency Education Relief (GEER) Fund. The U.S. Department of Education is required to allocate 60 percent of the funds based on each state's relative population of individuals aged 5 through 24, and 40 percent based on each state's relative number of children counted under the Title I, Part A formula.

GEER funds may be used by the Governor of Maine in support of public elementary and secondary education, institutions of higher education (IHEs), or other education-related entities. A Governor has wide discretion in determining the entities in the State that will receive GEER funds. A Governor can choose to fund only LEAs, only IHEs, only education-related entities, or any combination of eligible entities.

American Rescue Plan (ARP) Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) Fund

The American Rescue Plan (ARP) Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) Fund, authorized under the ARP Act of 2021, provides over \$411 million to Maine to support schools in safely reopening and sustaining safe operations while meeting the academic, social, emotional, and mental health needs of students resulting from the coronavirus disease 2019 (“COVID-19”) pandemic. It is particularly important that ARP ESSER funding will enable school administrative units (“SAUs”), and more directly schools, to support students who have been most severely impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic and are likely to have suffered the most because of longstanding inequities in our communities and schools that have been exacerbated by the COVID-19 pandemic.

The Maine Department of Education (DOE) is required to make allocations to SAUs in an expedited and timely manner. Section 2001(c) of the ARP requires the DOE to determine ARP ESSER Fund allocations based on the proportion that each State received under Title I, Part A of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) in the most recent fiscal year. Therefore, to determine the ARP ESSER Fund allocations, the Department used the fiscal year 2020 State shares of Title I, Part A allocations without the application of the hold harmless provisions in ESEA section 1122.

In order to make a significant portion of ARP ESSER funds available as quickly as possible, the Maine DOE is issuing through a Grant Award Notification (GAN) an award equal to two-thirds of the SAU's ARP ESSER allocation, which is listed below as the sub-award amount. The cumulative federal award amount is the SAU's total ARP ESSER allocation, which includes the sub-award amount.

The Maine Department of Education received a slight increase due to a downward revision by a State to data that the U.S. Department of Education used to calculate federal fiscal year 2020 and federal fiscal year 2019 Title I allocations.
