GEER

Allocations to Utah

Both the CARES Act and CRRSA Act provided funding to Governors through the Governor’s Emergency Education Relief (GEER) Fund. The U.S. Department of Education is required to allocate 60 percent of the funds based on each state’s relative population of individuals aged 5 through 24, and 40 percent based on each state’s relative number of children counted under the Title I, Part A formula.

GEER funds may be used by the Governor of Utah in support of public elementary and secondary education, institutions of higher education (IHEs), or other education-related entities. A Governor has wide discretion in determining the entities in the State that will receive GEER funds. A Governor can choose to fund only LEAs, only IHEs, only education-related entities, or any combination of eligible entities.

### Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act Funding

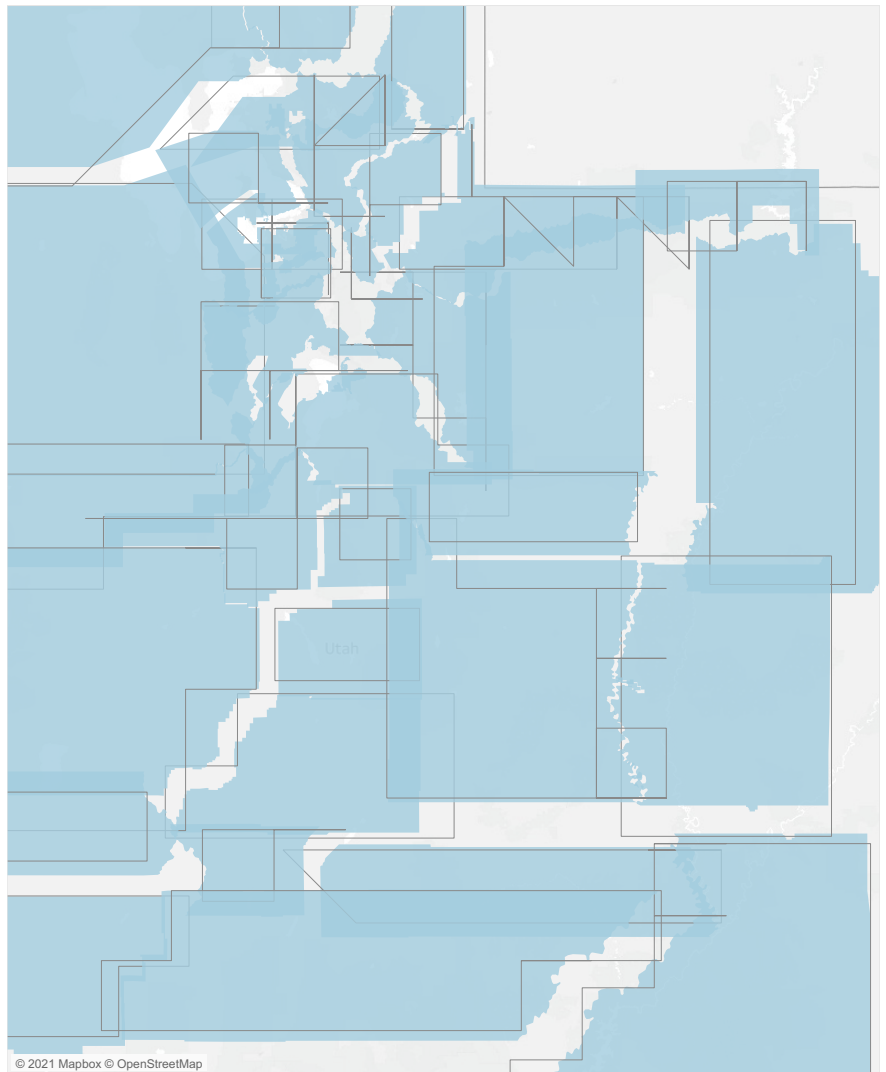
On March 17, 2020, Congress passed the **Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act**. Among other things, CARES allocated about \$13.2 billion to the **Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) Fund**.

Through the fund the United States Department of Education awarded grants to state educational agencies to provide Local Educational Agencies (LEAs) with emergency relief funds to address the impact of COVID-19 on elementary and secondary schools.

ESSER Fund awarded to state education agencies are in the same proportion as each state received funds under Part A of Title I of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 in fiscal year 2019. Utah received \$67,821,787 in ESSER Funding. Of that, \$61,039,608 was distributed to the state's district and charter schools according to the funding formula. This is represented in the map as **"ESSER Funds Distributed by Title I-A"**.

The Utah State Board of Education (USBE) has reserved \$6,782,179 to deal with statewide needs or specific needs within the state, including the procurement of personal protective equipment (PPE). Additionally, on Thursday, June 25, 2020 the Utah State Board of Education approved the use of \$755,054.95 from the state ESSER reserve to address LEAs that received no funds or less than the base amount of \$21,194, as the impacts of COVID-19 have been experienced by all schools. This is represented in the map as **"SEA 10% Reserve Base Funding"**.

Utah was allocated \$29,189,663 from the Governor's Emergency Education Relief Fund (GEER). This funding is to address student needs arising from the COVID-19 related disruption of the current academic year including continuing to provide educational services while schools are closed and supporting the ongoing functionality of those schools. GEER funds will be used to ensure that special education students and students at risk of academic failure receive support to mitigate the unintended negative academic consequences of the emergency statewide transition to remote learning. **This is represented in the map as "GEER Funding"**.
