RE: NEA Ballot Measure/Legislative Crisis Fund Report

BACKGROUND

The 2000 NEA Representative Assembly created the NEA Ballot Measure/Legislative Crisis Fund. The current special dues assessment for the Fund is \$20. The Board's guidelines for the Fund set out a process for review and evaluation of affiliate funding requests by an Oversight Committee consisting of the NEA Vice President and Secretary-Treasurer, the President of the National Council of State Education Associations, the NEA Senior Director of Communications, and the NEA Director of Campaigns and Elections. All recommendations of the Oversight Committee to allocate \$500,000 or less to a state affiliate during a membership year are forwarded to the NEA President and Executive Director for action.
