PURPOSE

The NEA-Retired Governance Committee oversees the governing documents of NEA-Retired and recommends revisions as needed. Those documents include the Standing Rules for the NEA-Retired Annual Meeting, the NEA-Retired Bylaws, the Procedures for Amending the NEA-Retired Bylaws, the Guidelines for the Submission and Adoption of New Business Items at the NEA-Retired Annual Meeting, and the various forms dealing with changes to these documents.

GOALS

1. The NEA-Retired Governance Committee strives to keep the governing documents of NEA-Retired up to date.
2. To that end, the committee receives input from members and affiliates regarding the NEA-Retired Bylaws, Standing Rules, and New Business Items. From that input, the Committee shapes language that reflects the ideas suggested by a member or affiliate, brings that language back to the member or affiliate for approval or amendment, and presents that language to the delegates at the NEA-Retired Annual Meeting for approval, amendment, referral, or defeat.
