When does registration begin?

Registration is scheduled to open Thursday, April 1, 2027, and will be open through Sunday, May 16, 2027 (or when registration reaches capacity, whichever comes first). The registration link is forthcoming.

What time does the Conference on Racial and Social Justice begin?

The Conference on Racial and Social Justice begins at 1:00 p.m. EST on Sunday, June 27, 2027. The Conference on Racial and Social Justice concludes at 2:00 p.m. EST on Tuesday, June 29, 2027. A complete agenda is forthcoming.
